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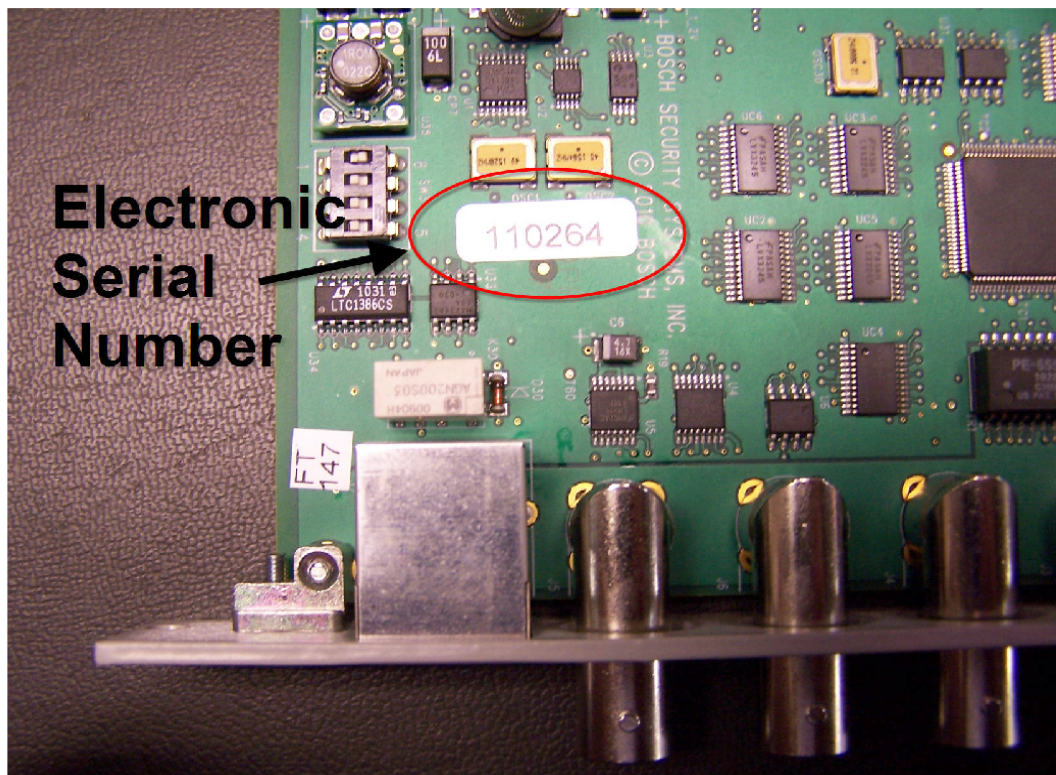
Subject: How to determine the electronic serial number of a MADI back card.

Overview

The electronic serial number of a MADI back card is a twelve digit decimal number. Six of these digits are unique and are needed to generate or update a license. Determining the electronic serial number of a MADI back card can be accomplished by one of two ways. The electronic serial number is printed on a label applied to the circuit board. Also, the electronic serial number is displayed electronically using the AZedit program.

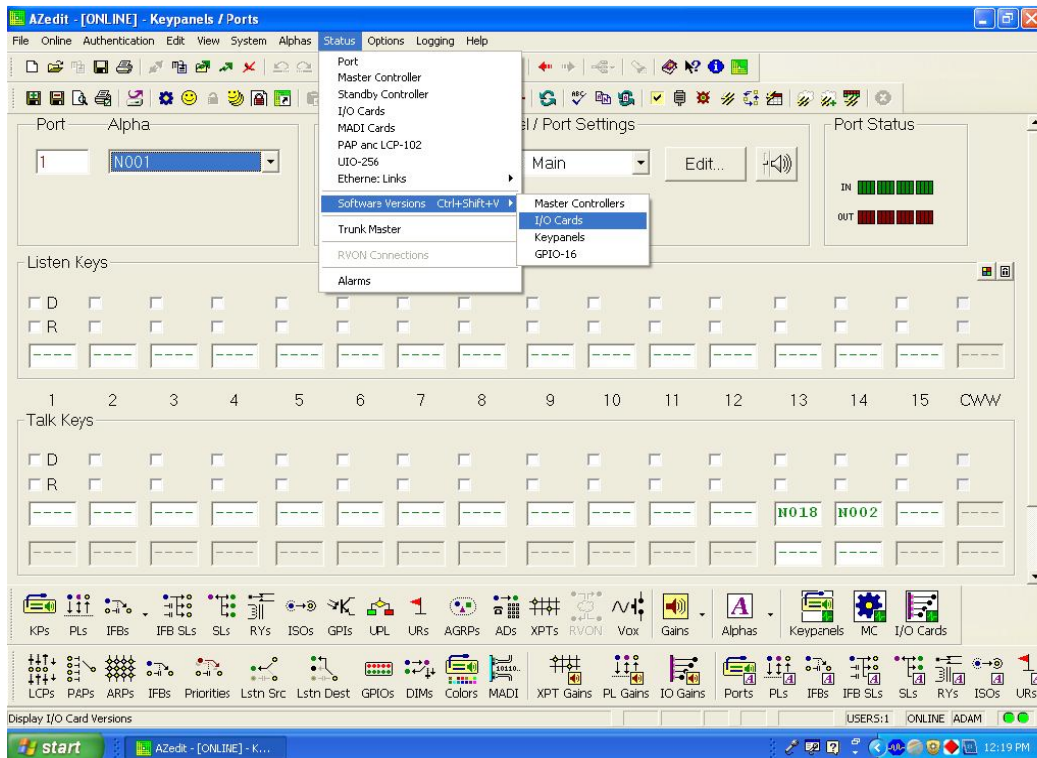
Label Method

- Only the six leased significant digits are listed on the label (the digits needed to generate or update a license).



AZedit Method

- The electronic serial number can be viewed in AZedit by the following menu steps:
 - ➔ Status
 - ➔ Software Versions
 - ➔ I/O Cards



- The actual serial number shows up at the end of the firmware string.
