Setup File Conversion Due To Master Controller Updates

The following is a revised simplified process by which upgrades to Master Controllers may be performed without the double-step manual convert process of setup files. This relates to upgrades of ADAM and ADAM-CS ver 8.xx to ver 9,5,2 or higher.

- 1.) Load current setup file with old Csedit or old ADAMedit and download to intercom frame if not already existing in frame.
- 2.) Run ADAMedit (latest version)
- 3.) Go on-line with existing older Master Controllers and allow ADAMedit to reconfigure to the older controllers.
- 4.) Next, save to file and specify a fname and path.
- 5.) Allow entry into file mode after file is saved if you wish.
- 6.) Exit ADAMedit and install new Master Controllers (Altera ver 4.1 or higher) or if already ver 4.1, with full complement of RAM, replace U2/U4 flash to upgraded ver.
- 7.) Re-load ADAMedit, go on-line and allow reconfiguration to new Masters.
- 8.) Load the file saved in Step 3 and check for duplicate alphas if desired.
- 9.) Click on "Send Changes".

NOTE: Step 9 might generate a warning that the saved intercom size is different, and that some data may be lost. In general, data is lost only if you reduce resources, *e.g. reduce the number of ISO's from 64 to 12, etc.*

This procedure must be repeated for each setup file to be converted. e.g. put old masters back in, load next setup file in old edit software, load new ADAMedit, save setup in new ADAMedit, etc., etc., etc.
