## **Changing Key Assignments with Partial Save**

This is to allow a quick method of reconfiguring a system setup involving just a few keypanels and saving a file for future modifications off line for other updates.

- 1. Select a keypanel from the KP view and make the desired changes to key assignments.
- 2. Select Partial Save from the File pull down menu. The panel you have been working on should be highlighted in the "selected" window.
- 3. In the Resource Type window, select "alphas" and in Alpha Type, select "ports".
- 4. In the Subset window, select "all alphas", click "add", then o.k.
- 5. Repeat sequence in **steps 3 and 4** for <u>Party Lines</u>, <u>IFB's</u>, <u>Special Lists</u>, <u>GPI Outputs</u>, <u>ISO's</u>, <u>&</u> <u>UPL Resources</u>.
- 6. Now name the file and click "save".
- 7. Select enter "file mode", then click "continue".
- 8. In the Edit pull down, click "copy", then "paste special".
- 9. De-select all boxes that appear in this next screen except "talk & listen assignments, select "all keys", then the ports you want to change, then select "paste".
- 10. Click on "partial save" again but don't change anything and click o.k. If prompted to overwrite file, click o.k.
- 11. Go "on line" to "send file" and select the file you just created and send it.

This file may be edited off line and re-sent for other changes.
