Product description

The WFMRACK-NN, WFMRACK-ON, and WFMRACK-S2 are designed to house two half-rack instruments side-by-side in a rack.

Supported products

This rack comes in the following three configurations.

WFMRACK-NN

Tektronix part number 650-4445-XX. This configuration contains two N sleeves and can house two of any of the following instruments in any combination:

- WFM700
- WFM6000, WFM6100, WFM6120
- WFM7000, WFM7020, WFM7100, WFM7120, WFM7200
- WFM8200, WFM8300
- AMM768
- MTX100A and MTX100B
- RTX A series and RTX B series

Information about installing short depth instruments. This configuration also includes two adapters for accommodation of Tektronix short depth waveform monitors.

NOTE. If you want to house only short depth instruments, use the short depth rack adapter. (See page 4, WFMRACK-S2.)

Information about utility drawers. If you only have one instrument in the rack adapter, you can purchase a 1700F07 utility drawer to install in the other side of the rack adapter. This drawer can be used to house accessory items. With the tray secured to the rear of the rack adapter, the drawer can be opened and closed freely, unless latched.

WFMRACK-ON

Tektronix part number 650-4394-XX. This configuration contains one O sleeve and one N sleeve and can house one of the instruments in Table 1 with one of the instruments in Table 2.

Information about utility drawers. If you only have one instrument in the rack adapter, you can purchase a 1700F07 utility drawer to install in the other side of the rack adapter. This drawer can be used to house accessory items. With the tray secured to the rear of the rack adapter, the drawer can be opened and closed freely, unless latched.

WFMRACK-S2

Tektronix part number 650-5575-XX. This configuration contains one rack adapter for the following short depth instruments.

Information about blank panels. If you only have one instrument in the rack adapter, you can install a blank panel in the other side of the rack adapter to improve appearance. The WFMRACK-S2 configuration ships with a blank panel, which may or may not already be installed.




Figure 1: WFMRACK-NN/ON rack adapter parts




Figure 2: WFMRACK-NN/ON rack adapter dimensions




Figure 3: Rear bracket guide dimensions




Figure 4: WFMRACK-S2 rack adapter parts




Figure 5: WFMRACK-S2 rack adapter dimensions

Installation

These instructions are for personnel who are familiar with the product. If you need assistance, contact your nearest Tektronix, Inc., Service Center.

Rack adapter cooling and clearance requirements



CAUTION. To prevent risk of fire, adequate airflow to instrument(s) and rack adapter must be maintained. Failure to provide adequate airflow to instrument(s) could cause an instrument to shut down. Inadequate airflow includes placing instrument(s) and rack adapter in any small, enclosed room that lacks a ventilation system, such as a closet. If the airflow is restricted or blocked and the instrument(s) do not shut down, the risk of fire is increased and the instrument(s) could be permanently damaged.

Each instrument has specific cooling and clearance requirements. Refer to the cooling and clearance information for the individual instruments you are installing before installing them. This information is available in the user manuals and other documentation specific to those instruments. Ensure that the clearance requirements for proper airflow are met for both the rack adapter and the instrument.


Install bracket for Tektronix short depth waveform monitors

If you will be installing a Tektronix short depth waveform monitor into the WFMRACK-ON or -NN rack adapter, you need to install a short configuration bracket into the sleeve before you mount the rack adapter into a rack. Tektronix short depth waveform monitors can only be mounted in N sleeves (those with a smooth (no seam) bottom panel).

NOTE. If you want a rack adapter that houses only short depth waveform monitors, use the WFMRACK-S2 configuration. (See page 4, WFMRACK-S2.)

To install the short depth configuration bracket:

- 1. Set the cabinet assembly down so the top of the assembly is up.
- **2.** Place the short configuration bracket on the bottom panel of the sleeve as shown in the following illustration.



3. Secure the short configuration bracket to the sleeve using two 6/32" screws.

Install the WFMRACK-NN or -ON into the rack

Before you install an instrument into the rack adapter, install the adapter into the rack as follows:

NOTE. The numbers in brackets in the following procedure refer to the circled numbers in the figure and in the parts list. (See page 5.)




Figure 6: Adjusting the position of the handles

The rack adapter is marked with the word "TOP" to indicate which side of the adapter should face up. (See Figure 6.)

- 1. If desired, you can adjust the position of the handle brackets to mount the adapter flush with other equipment in the rack. To do this, loosen the nuts that attach the handle brackets to the rack adapter, adjust the position of the handle brackets as desired, and then tighten the nuts securely. (See Figure 6.)
- 2. Secure the rack adapter assembly to the front frame of the rack using four screws and four shoulder washers.
- **3.** Install one guide bracket to one side of the rear frame of the rack using the screws and nut bar provided in the kit.
- **4.** Secure the guide bracket to the rack adapter, using the nut bar and attaching hardware. Use the holes in the bracket that will accommodate the depth of the instrument rack frame being used. Leave the screws loose.
- **5.** Install the other guide bracket to the other side of the rear frame of the rack, using the screws and nut bar.
- **6.** Secure the guide bracket to the rack adapter, using the nut bar and attaching hardware.
- 7. Tighten all attaching screws that were left loose in the previous steps.

Install an instrument into the WFMRACK-NN or -ON rack adapter

With the rack adapter already installed in the rack, install the instrument into the rack adapter as follows:



CAUTION. When working with instruments that are not enclosed in a chassis, you must observe static precautions. You must also be careful not to damage circuit board mounted components or interconnection wiring when sliding a sleeve over these products.

1. Refer to the *Supported Products* section of this document to ensure you are installing the correct combination of instruments into the rack adapter. (See page 2.)

The ventilation holes and EMI shielding on the rack adapters are specially designed to meet the requirements of the instruments for which they were intended.

- **3.** Secure the instrument in the sleeve as follows:
 - For Tektronix short depth waveform monitors, reach into the sleeve from the rear of the sleeve and secure the instrument to the short configuration bracket using two attaching screws.
 - For all other instruments, on the rear panel, install and tighten two attaching screws through the tabs on the rear panel into the instrument.

Install the WFMRACK-S2 into the rack

Before you install an instrument into the rack adapter, install the adapter into the rack as follows:

NOTE. The numbers in brackets in the following procedure refer to the circled numbers in the figure and in the parts list. (See page 9.)

- 1. If desired, adjust the position of the handle brackets to mount the adapter flush with other equipment in the rack. To do this, loosen the nuts that attach the handle brackets to the rack adapter, adjust the position of the handle brackets as desired, and then tighten the nuts securely. The handle brackets adjust the same way for the WFMRACK-S2 and for the WFMRACK-NN and -ON. (See Figure 6.)
- 2. Secure the [1] rack adapter assembly to the front frame of the rack using four [5] screws and four [3] shoulder washers.

Install an instrument into the WFMRACK-S2 rack adapter

With the rack adapter already installed in the rack, install the instrument into the rack adapter as follows:

NOTE. The numbers in brackets in the following procedure refer to the circled numbers in the figure and in the parts list. (See page 9.)



CAUTION. When working with instruments that are not enclosed in a chassis, you must observe static precautions. You must also be careful not to damage circuit board mounted components or interconnection wiring when sliding a sleeve over these products.

1. Refer to the *Supported Products* section of this document to ensure you are installing the correct combination of instruments into the rack adapter. (See page 2.)
