In this menu you can save/load scenefiles on USB-disk which must be available in the CCS-One.

Here it is also possible to create directories, rename, delete and lock/unlock saved files and adding comments to a saved file.

Note that the files are NOT compatible with MCP450, and can NOT be used on the camera head directly !

• Share scene settings across multiple cameras: <u>This</u> button is available via the "Share" tab.



In this menu it is possible to select any camera and directly copy the scene file settings to one or more of MyCameras.



• Possibility to release selected User Profile when leaving desk in order to secure that nobody can make changes to the camera settings while leaving the desk.

or for every camera in My Cameras using the button on the CGA.

Selecting the *i* button, the following additional information will appear on the screen:

- Rename a Snapshot for easier recognition
- Recall any previous Snapshot to compare results
- For each camera, up to 10 Snapshots are kept for recall
- When creating more than 10 Snapshots, the oldest Snapshot is automatically removed
- Snapshots can be protected against removal in case limit of 10 is reached
- Save the best Snapshot as real scene-file
- Snapshots are kept within your User Profile
- When a camera is removed from MyCameras, corresponding Snapshots are deleted
- Snapshots are lost with a reboot of the Creative Grading Engine
- Any Snapshot is automatically deleted 48 hours after creation

Menu control of Camera/XCU available in the App (via Setup > Camera or Setup > Basestation)



Once "Menu Ctrl" is selected, the Camera/XCU menu can be controlled (and is visible) via the App. It can also be controlled via the CGP rotary/push button.
