#### Who is this guide for?

This guide is intended for the user who as physical access to the Kaleido series and as basic knowledge of this type of equipment.

#### What is this guide for?

To give user of KaleidoX frame the knowledge how to upgrade the firmware using a USB connector on the device using a USB KEY!.

This is good for ALL Kaleido-X frame type. FR 4, FR 7 or FR 14. This guide is also for system that have no issue, and are simply undergoing normal update procedure to keep up to date with latest GrassValley technology.



#### What will I need to perform the UPDATE?

- Physical access to the Kaleido Frame
- Access to a Microsoft Windows Computer
- 1 USB Stick (4 gig minimum)
- The latest firmware from Grassvalley support.
- Custom KaleidoX software to prepare the USB stick
- SSH program like putty

#### What is this Custom KaleidoX software doing?

The program will upgrade the cards firmware for the Kaleido-X, FR4, FR7, and FR14. The procedure implies the use of 2 files.

- Firmware file
- Program to prepare an USB key to push the firmware into the KX Upgrading firmware will automatically propagate it the other cards.

### How much down time should I expect?

Be prepared for a 5 minutes shutdown window when you decide to use the reboot button that will show on the Kaleido screen at the end of the firmware update.

20-35 minutes is needed between every card Updating

The reboot button will show up after the firmware is completely integrated in the memory. All important information is also displayed in the main screen of the Kaleido in a kind of dashboard on the lower left corner.

#### Why do I need to upgrade?

If you have to replace a broken board with a newer one. If you want to follow up with newest technologies brake through. If you want to overpass certain limitation or bug firmware version related problem.

6. When prompted to select an update file, Browse to the GV-KX folder that you have created on the desktop in step1 locate and double-click on the Kaleido-X operating system file (form "kxos-XXX_BUILD_XXXX.os"):	Select Fall Select
