Kayak Control Panel Default Mode Keycaps

Purpose

Kayak 1-, 2-, and 3-M/E panel buttons can be changed to operate with the new software Default Mode for Keyers and E-MEMs.

Parts List

A button replacement set (Part # 721001101) is provided that accommodates all main Kayak panel types:

• Keycap Set, Kayak Control Panel Default Mode (supplied)

Required Tools

The following tools are required for installation, but are not supplied:

• Lens Remover Part # 003177900

Keycaps Installation Procedure

To install the Default Mode keycaps:


1. Take the keycap removal tool (Lens Remover Part Number 003177900) to the Kayak panel where you want to replace the buttons.

2. If you have previously received a button replacement kit, you may have the keycap removal tool that was shipped with that kit (Part Number 003177900). This tool works for removing keycaps also.






Figure 3. Kayak E-MEM Keycaps Installed in DD Mode

3. See Figure 3 on page 5 for examples of the E-MEM key placement for the DD Mode (as shipped) and for the Default Mode (new keycaps after replacement).

You are going to remove the keycap buttons shown in Figure 3 on page 5 and replace them so that the keycap button arrangement looks like that shown in Figure 4 on page 5


4. Position the removal tool over the top and bottom of the keycap you want to remove, taking care not to break the lens. Make sure the ends of the tool are flush with the bottom of the keycap.

Use the smaller size grip on the removal tool for the smaller buttons and the larger grip for the larger buttons.

5. Lift the keycap from the switcher with the tool.


CAUTION Do not use the removal tool to place the keycaps on the switcher. This can damage the keycaps.

Figure 5. Keycap Removal





6. Using your hands (not the removal tool) place the new keycap into the hole noting that the plastic alignment tabs on the keycap are positioned vertically (aligned with the top and bottom of the switcher).

7. Press gently but firmly to secure the keycap into place over the switch.




Figure 8. Kayak Keyer Keycaps Installed in DD Mode

8. Now repeat Step 1 through Step 7to replace the keycap buttons on the switcher for the keyer. The DD Mode arrangement for the Keyer buttons is shown in Figure 8, and the new Default Mode arrangement is shown in Figure 9 on page 8.
